Media Tour of Journalists to meet CSOs in Tayush and Gegharkunik

In June 2016 Media Initiative Center organized a media tour to Tavush and Gegharkunik marzes (provinces) as part of CSO DePo program. The purpose of the media tour was to introduce journalists to the activities of Civil Society Organizations operating in various communities outside the capital, and to the problems of these communities.

Total 13 journalists representing 9 media outlets (TV, radio, print and online media) participated in the media tour. During two days the journalists visited seven NGOs: Geghareg Educational and Cultural NGO (Gavar); Martuni Women's Community Council (Martuni); Community Pulse (Vardenik); Astghatsolk NGO of Disabled Children's Parents (Chambarak); Support to Noyemberyan (Noyemberyan); Natali Center for Childcare (Dovegh); Noyastgh (Koghb).

CSOs presented their various activities and initiatives, as well as introduced their areas of expertise and their roles in communities. Thus, journalists got better understanding on CSOs functioning in the region. As a result, an extensive coverage of various issues appeared in media through almost 25 informative and analytical reports in different formats – print, online, audio, video, multimedia. The issues and initiatives covered included: summer camp for children of dead soldiers; employment and vocational education of young people; business initiatives of CSOs; social and economic problems in villages; employment opportunities for the disabled people; childcare and child development; migration; agriculture.
